- *Dues giving was down 19 percent in '09 vs. '08 (\$16,800 vs. \$20,750), total membership is down 15 percent to 77.*
- *11 new members in 2009.*
- *23 members failed to renew in 2009.*
- *In the past 5 year period Home PAC has had as many as 99 members (2007) and as few as 58 (2005).*



Expense Summary:

- **In total, TABA HomePAC distributed about \$20,000 in the most recent election cycle (08-09).**
- *The majority of our expenditures went to support candidates in 08 and local bond initiatives in 09.*
- *Local races we'd normally engage in we're uncontested in 2009 (ie: City and School District). There were no county or state races in 2009.*
- *Continued support of our industry's state political action committee, Texas Association of Builders HomePAC.*

March 2nd: Primary election day.

March 15th: Last day to register to vote in runoff for primary.

April 5th– April 9th: Early voting for primary runoff.

April 13th: Primary Runoff election day.

*October 18th – 29th: Early voting for general election. (October 12th:
Elected Officials Night)*

November 2nd: General Election Day

Feb 6th – March 8th: Filing for local elections.

April 8th: Last day to register to vote.

April 26th – May 4th: Early voting.

Local Election Day is May 10th.
